Has an "8" with a box on the left hip, Green ear tag with the #4. Approximately 6 months of age. Has some "road rash" as if it has fallen out of a trailer.

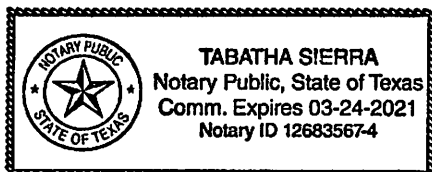
