

Visitor Screening COVID-19

1. Are you experiencing signs and symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as fever, cough, shortness of breath or sore throat?
2. In the last 14 days, have you had contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, or under investigation for COVID-19, or someone ill with a respiratory illness?
3. Have you had any international travel within the last 14 days to a country with sustained community transmission? (see attached)
4. Are you residing in a community where community-based spread of COVID-19 is occurring?
5. Have you taken any recent trips (within 14 days) on a cruise ship or other setting where crowds are confined to a common location? If you answer yes to this question we ask that you defer your visit to a later date. If your visit is necessary, you should use PPE while onsite. If we do not have PPE, we are asking that you restrict your visit and come back at a later date (e.g., after 14 days with no symptoms of COVID-19).
