Commissioner Rosson made a motion to approve the routine administrative items as presented. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

4. Consider approving tournament requests; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Rosson made a motion to approve the tournament requests as presented by Shaun McDonald, Golf Pro. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

5. Consider authorizing alternate access points to Gaines County Golf Course; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Murphree stated Artie Giesbrecht had contacted him regard tearing down a portion of the fence that divides the North Subdivision and the Golf Course and allow him to build a brick entrance into the Golf Course. Commissioner Murphree stated there had been an agreement between Artie and the County in 2017 regarding a right of way and accessing the fence. Commissioner Murphee made a motion to authorize Artie Giesbrecht to tear down the said portion of the fence to construct a brick entry way into the Golf Course from the North Subdivision. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Notion carried unanimously.

6. Open bids for Extension Office pickup; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Belt made a motion at approve the bid from Lawrence Hall Chevrolet-Buick-GMC for 2021 Chevrolet pickup in the amount of \$56,288.77 FOR Terry Millican, Extension Office. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

7. Consider going out for bids for a replacement van for the Gaines County Senior Citizens Centers, moving the van currently in use to the Maintenance Department; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Rosson, Precinct 1, made a motion to approve transferring the Senior Citizens van in Seagraves that is currently in his shop to the Senior Citizens in Seminole, therefore transferring Senior Citizens Van in Seminole to the Maintenance Department. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

8. Consider approving contracts with Trane for replacement of air conditioners at the Gaines County Annex (old library) in Seagraves and the Chamber of Commerce building in Seminole; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Belt made a motion to approve the contracts with Trane for replacement of air conditioners at the Old Library (\$12,697.00) and Chamber of Commerce (\$9,970.00) buildings. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

9. Consider going out for a Request for Proposal for replacement of fuel tanks at the Gaines County Airport, to include new tanks, pumps, plumbing, and retention berm; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Murphree made a motion to authorize going out for proposals for replacement of fuel tanks at the Gaines County Airport. Commissioner Rosson seconded the notion. Motion carried unanimously.

10. Consider approval of the Fixed Base Operator contract and authorizing the County Judge to sign the contract on behalf of Gaines County, take action as appropriate

Commissioner Murphree made a motion to approve the Fixed Base Operator contract and authorize Judge Keyes to sign said contract. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

Commissioner Rosson made a motion authorizing to pay the adjustment of \$10, regarding the error in sending Precinct 1 a 2 wheel drive pickup (\$28,423.62) in error, a 4 wheel drive (\$28,433.62) was to be the original order. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

- 13. Consider authorizing the County Judge to sign an invoice to cover cost over runs in the project to replace flooring in the Mental Health and the South Plains Public Health Departments; take action as appropriate
 - Commissioner Rosson made a motion to authorize Judge Keyes to sign an invoice to cover the cost over runs to replace flooring in the South Plains Public Health Department for \$3,000.00, which is half the cost per agreement with 4T Industry. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

Judge Keyes stated Nick Castillo, Maintenance, stated the roof was under warranty. A representative from Andrus Brothers Roofing was in attendance and stated the issues relating to the roof repair were not covered under the warranty. He stated the hail damage should be covered under the County insurance. Nick Castillo stated he had contacted the insurance company and the adjustor would be coming to look at the roof damage.

Commissioner Murphree made a motion to approve a cost of living raise of 1.5% for county employees. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Rosson made a motion to approve the part time employee, Stephen Gelhaus, in the District Clerks office from a part time to a full time employee. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Esmeralda Felan, Auditor, stated she would be sending out the "spending" letter for this year's budget soon.
