Court observed a moment of silence followed by the opening invocation given by Judge Keyes, who then led the pledge to the flags. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

## 1. <u>Discuss routine administrative items</u>: take action needed;

# 2. Consider authorizing the auditor to issue a credit card for the Constable; take action as appropriate

Judge Keyes presented a written request from Constable Chad Hallum for issuance of a county credit card. Commissioner Houston made a motion approving the issuance, with a second by Commissioner Rosson. Motion carried unanimously.

## 3. Consider approving racial profiling report; take action as appropriate

Sheriff Pipkin presented and reviewed the 2016 Racial Profiling Report filed with the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement. Commissioner Belt made a motion accepting and approving the report as presented. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

## 4. Consider going out for bids for gravel and asphalt; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Belt made a motion to go out for bids for gravel and asphalt, with a second by Commissioner Houston. Bids to be opened March 13<sup>th</sup>. Motion carried unanimously.

## 5. Consider going out for bids for gravel hauling; take action as appropriate

## 6. Consider approving a contract to buy caliche; take action as appropriate

Commissioner Houston presented a contract to buy caliche from Conney E Menix for Precinct 4. To be removed from the pit at Block 30 Section 293 @ \$2.00 for each cubic yard. Motion made by Commissioner Houston, second by Commissioner Rosson. Motion carried unanimously.

#### 7. Consider approving purchase of internet filter; take action as appropriate

Scott Shortes, Internet Technology Director, presented a software program to filter internet, with other security features. Shortes recommended this software through

SIGMA, a Cisco umbrella. This is a DIR contract, 3 year agreement, auto renewing each year, covering 104 desktops totals \$10,619.44. Commissioner Houston made a motion approving the software purchase. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

8. Discuss the FY 2017 TxDot County Assistance Program; take action as appropriate

Randy Davis, TxDot Manager, addressed the court regarding the FY 2017 County Assistance Program. Davis stated he has 500 yards of Grade 5 rock available at \$55.66 yard for a total of approximately \$25,330.00. According to the rotating schedule, this rock will go to Precinct 3. Commissioner Murphree made a motion to accept the rock, with a second by Commissioner Belt. Motion carried unanimously.

9. Consider approving auditors request to purchase a new financial server for the county; take action as appropriate

Rick Dollahan, County Auditor, stated the financial server needs to be updated and replaced. Dollahan stated there is money in his budget for this purchase. Commissioner Belt made a motion authorizing the Judge to sign the lease purchase paperwork for the server. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.
